



Hospitality Group Position Description

Volunteer as a Hospitality Group and experience what a night in shelter is really like. This volunteer position is catered towards small groups of volunteers (church groups, professional groups, families, neighbors, or friends). The position purchases, prepares, transports, and serves an evening meal for residents at The Cathedral Center.

The Cathedral Center is a shelter for women and families facing an emergency housing crisis. We are home to 32 women and 8 families for up to 90 days while they work with our case managers to achieve a personal action plan. Volunteers help us keep things running smoothly and provide the comforts of home through our Hospitality Program!

Groups of 5-8 people sign up to provide a meal which they purchase, prepare, and serve to our clients on a monthly or semi-monthly basis. Through this program we are able to provide a meal 365 days a year! Our Hospitality Program is great for parish groups, clubs and organizations, corporate groups, and friends and families who want to serve a home cooked meal with a friendly face. Groups are needed 7 days a week between 6:30-8pm.

Groups must be comfortable interacting with homeless adults with mental illness and addictions, as well as, children ranging from infant-18 years old. All volunteers must complete and pass a background check before volunteering.
